What's new in 2024

Increasing numbers of schoolchildren

The number of schoolchildren attending the Festival continues to rise year after year. This year, the Festival welcomed almost 3,000 schoolchildren, a figure we are truly proud of, as it is part of our drive to raise awareness of the marine world and its fragility.

During the Festival, we were able to offer conferences with local players, notably on **Posidonie** for the BTS environment students. There were also shows for younger audiences, including **Bernard Abeille**, our resident artist, and **"Le Monde du Silence Gueule"**, a standup comedy written by Julia Duchaussoy.



New spaces



The association was fortunate enough to **expand to six different venues** for the ninth edition: the Forum du Casino, the Casino auditorium, the Médiathèque, the Salle Benoîte Groult, the Théâtre Denis and the Anglican Church.

Arts et Travels Space

A new area has been added to the Galathea Festival this year: the **Arts and Travel area**. A space combining **artists and tour operators** to make our visitors dream and travel.




Didier Noirot - President
